

Love One Another; John 13:34-35

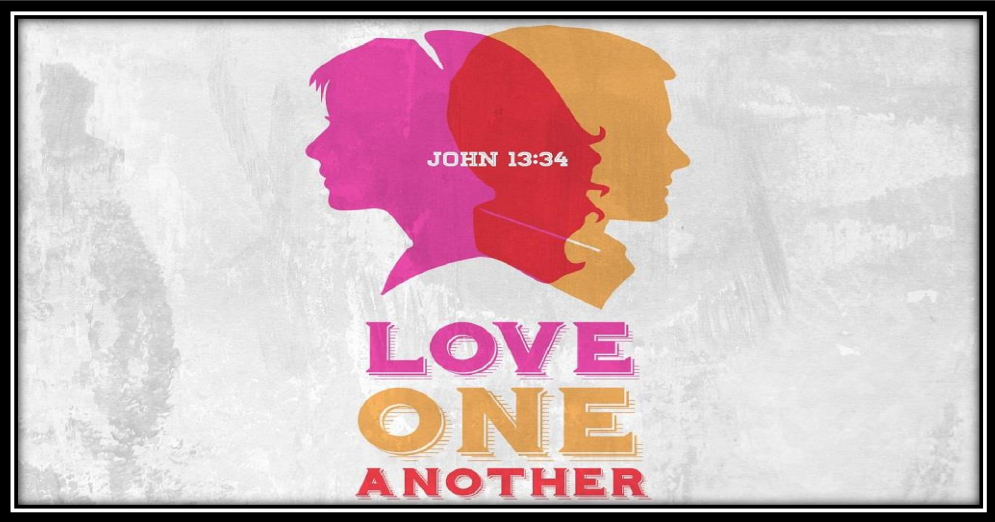
- I. Love
