Covid-19

How It Changed The World

As you well know, in March the world was turned upside down because of Covid-19. P.J. Hardy and I returned from Haiti the day before the border was closed, we were thankful. There were mission trips planned for Jamaica, Aruba, Curacao and Bonaire and four or five more trips to Haiti, all of these were put on hold. We thought the virus would be gone in a few weeks. Now it is mid-November and Covid-19 is still with us. I look forward to a better year in 2021.

It is sad that people around the world have suffered and many have died because of the virus. I also was infected, but the symptoms were very lite, and I am 100% recovered. My one-year old granddaughter, Charlotte, also had the it but is doing great.

Haiti has had 9,191 cases reported and 232 deaths. We are thankful to report that none of the students or teachers have had the virus.

January Mission Trip To Haiti

Plans are underway for our next trip to Haiti. It will have been nine months between trips, the longest span since my first trip, in February 2010. Please pray that there will be no delays or cancellations.

The school was closed for several weeks, as was most of the country. A few months ago, IST was allowed to resume classes. We have seven new students, fourteen in the second-year class and seven in the third-year class. We are very proud of our students and the work they are doing. Through the students and teachers there are about twenty-five baptisms each month, even during a pandemic.

The trip in January has two main objectives; one, teaching a short course. I will be teaching the first-year class, *How We Got The Bible*. P.J. Hardy, who travels with me regularly, will be teaching, *1st & 2nd Timothy and Titus*, to the rest of the students. Our second objective is to discuss the possibility of having a Saturday school. Many of the current preachers in Haiti have a desire to attend IST but are unable to do so during the week. We want to meet this need and help equip the preachers with the material to reach the lost souls of Haiti. We believe the Saturday program will answer the need.

Please pray for our travels, pray for the students and teachers, pray for the church in Haiti and the people of Haiti.

The International School of Theology - Haiti

The International School of Theology (IST) is an extension of the Bear Valley Bible Institute, Denver, Colorado. The goal and purpose of IST is to equip preachers and teaches to share the message of Christ. Some of the students do not intend to be fulltime preachers, they simply want to be better teachers of God's word. The ladies who attend want to learn God's word so they can share it with others, teach children, and other ladies.

Most of students already preach or teach in their home congregations. Most of the preachers in Haiti, do not earn a salary for preaching; they simply have a desire to share the message of Christ. IST was established in 2014 and since that time, more than 1,300 souls have come to Christ through this effort. We give God all the glory, for we know we are his tools on earth. These are some of our students and teachers.

As IST grows, so do the needs. Inflation in Haiti for 2020 is more than 18% since the same time last year. This reduces the buying power for the people but it also reduces the buying power for IST. I serve under the oversight of the elders at the Broad Street Congregation in Lexington, TN. 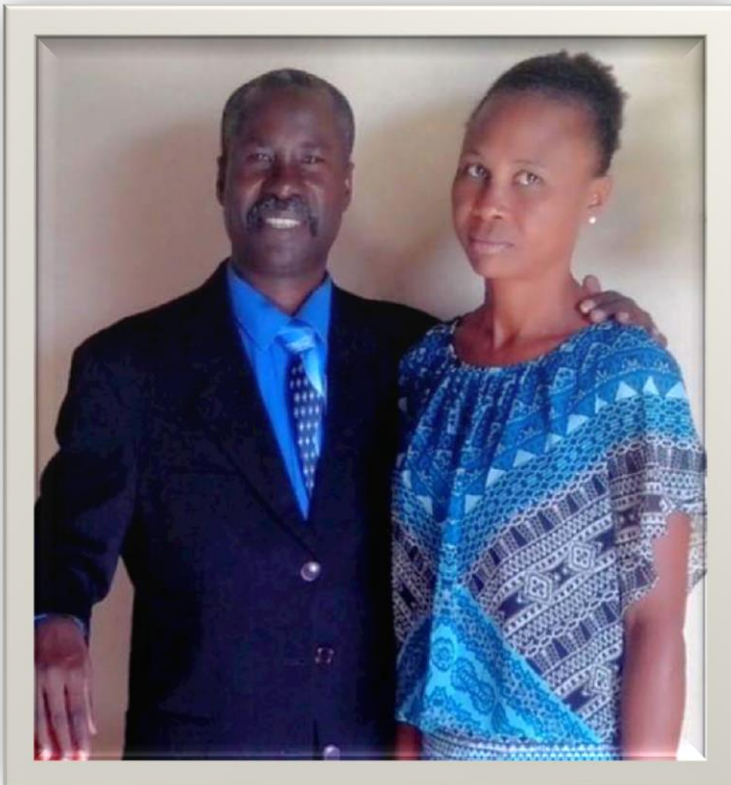

The home employs people to help with the cooking, cleaning, and tutoring of the children. This does not mean the children are not required to work in the home. Each child has responsibilities assigned to them to help build corrector, self-respect, leadership and to respect others.
