King of My Heart; Matthew 6:19-21

- I. Heart
  - a. We associate the heart with life
    - i. It pumps blood and oxygen to our bodies
    - ii. Without it, we would die
    - iii. Leviticus 17:11 (ESV)<sup>11</sup> For the life of the flesh is in the blood, and I have given it for you on the altar to make atonement for your souls, for it is the blood that makes atonement by the life.
  - b. We make promises, swear oaths, pledge allegiance with it
  - c. We associate the heart with love and passion
    - i. We use heart symbols to express our love for one another
    - ii. "I love you with all of my heart"
  - d. Center of the emotions, wishes, desires <sup>1</sup>
    - i. "Heart as seat of physical, spiritual and mental life
    - ii. As the center and source of physical life
    - iii. As center and source of the whole inner life, w. its thinking, feeling, and volition"<sup>2</sup>
    - iv. Matthew 5:8 (ESV) <sup>8</sup> "Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God.
  - e. Where is your Heart?
- II. Passion
  - a. Passion defined
    - i. Intense, driving, or overmastering (dominant) feeling or conviction
    - ii. Ardent affection: love
    - iii. A strong liking or desire for or devotion to some activity, object, or concept
    - iv. An object of desire or deep interest <sup>3</sup>
    - v. Luke 22:41–44 (ESV) <sup>41</sup> And he withdrew from them about a stone's throw, and knelt down and prayed, <sup>42</sup> saying, "Father, if you are willing, remove this cup from me. Nevertheless, not my will, but yours, be done." <sup>43</sup> And there appeared to him an angel from heaven, strengthening him. <sup>44</sup> And being in agony he prayed more earnestly; and his sweat became like great drops of blood falling down to the ground.
    - vi. From the Latin word 'pati' which means 'to suffer' (compassion is 'to suffer with')
  - b. We all have a passion for something, it drives our choices
    - i. Our career choices, "If you are passionate about your job, you'll never work a day in your life"
      - 1. We work hard to learn our chosen profession

- 3. It is easy to see when people are passionate about their profession by the quality of their work
- ii. Our choice of hobbies
  - 1. We spend time, money, and effort
  - 2. "Everybody's "Working for the weekend" (1981, Loverboy)
    - a. This song made the "top 100 songs of the 80's" list
    - b. Saturday Night Live, Family Guy, the 5 O'clock Whistle radio program in the mid-1980's
    - c. It was used in movies; Zoolander, Herbie: Fully Loaded, Pixels
  - 3. This song resonated with people because it represented the passion we have for our hobbies
- c. What is your Passion?

## III. King

- a. One who rules as possessor of the highest office in a political realm; one who possesses unusual or transcendent (being beyond comprehension) power <sup>4</sup>
- b. It goes far beyond a ruler with unlimited power
- c. Acts 2:36 (ESV) <sup>36</sup> Let all the house of Israel therefore know for certain that God has made him both Lord and Christ, this Jesus whom you crucified."
  - i. One who is a master, one who owns
  - ii. Genesis 1:1–3 (ESV) <sup>1</sup> In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth. <sup>2</sup> The earth was without form and void, and darkness was over the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters. <sup>3</sup> And God said, "Let there be light," and there was light.
  - iii. We claim the rights over the things we created (even intellectual property)
  - iv. Genesis 1:27 (ESV) <sup>27</sup> So God created man in his own image, in the image of God he created him; male and female he created them.
  - v. 1 Corinthians 6:20 (ESV) <sup>20</sup> for you were bought with a price. So glorify God in your body.
- d. Everyone reports to someone
  - i. I used to say this all the time in the Military
  - ii. It didn't matter how many stripes you had (or if you had brass on your collar), you reported to someone
  - iii. Even those who are "their own boss" are responsible to their customers
- e. The quicker we understand that we are servants (slaves), the easier it is to choose our king
- f. Who is your king?
- IV. King of My Heart
  - a. The mountain where I run, the fountain I drink from
  - b. The shadow where I hide, the ransom for my life
