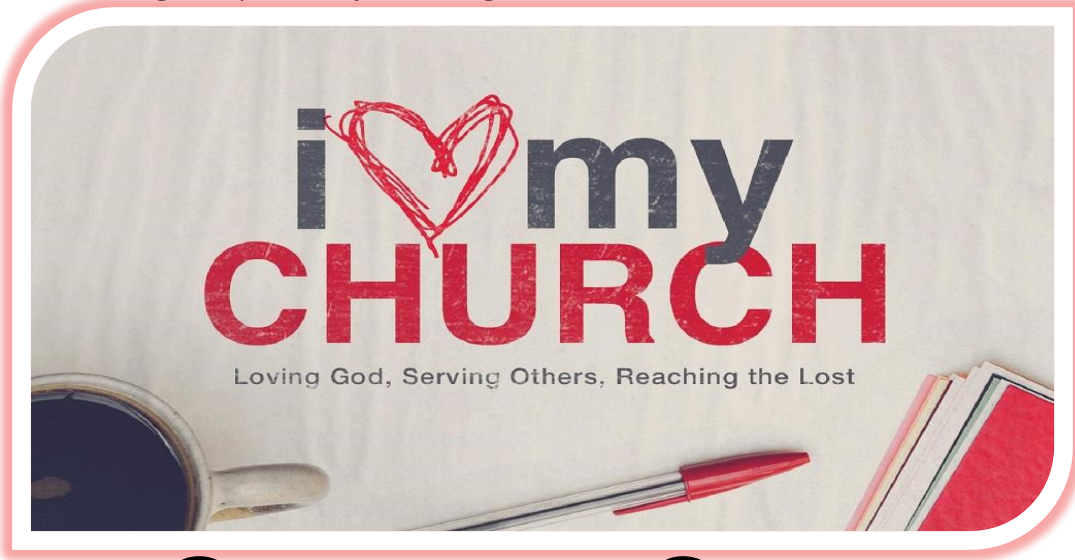
- I. Corporations
