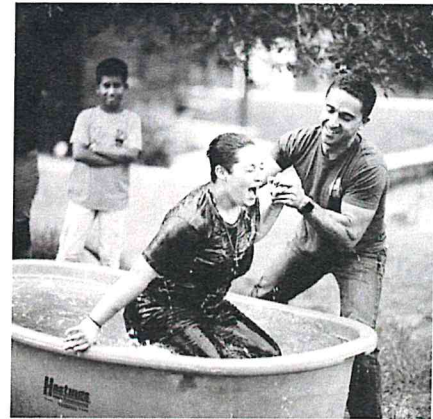
Dear Brethren:

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Here in Portales we've had some triple-digit temperatures in recent weeks, so it sure feels as though summer has arrived. To remove any doubt, at NMCCH there are yards to mow, weeds to pull, our trip to church camp, summer sports camps, visiting volunteer work groups, cookouts, and of course 4-H. That's summer at NMCCH, in full swing.

In the summer, the workday of a houseparent is fourteen and a half hours. It can be, and often is, exhausting. In the summer, our physical plant and maintenance staff don't get to conveniently move inside where it's cool. They keep right on working, maintaining youth cottages, our single parent homes, our young adult homes, and our new mother homes. They still mow fields and run fence lines. By the time summer is over, our farm and livestock employees will have visibly lost pounds and inches simply from physical exertion. And I can say for all of these people that there's nothing else they'd rather be doing. I say all of this because I am proud of our staff. I am proud of their work, and I am proud of their hearts.
