- 1. Text: Matthew 16:13-19.
- 2. The New Testament church is spoken of in two different senses Universal and Local.
- 3. It is also spoken of in different figures (Ephesians 6:10ff; Matthew 21:28; Ephesians 5:22ff; 1 Corinthians 12:13ff.
- 4. None of these figures is as sweet and affectionate as the "family of God" (Ephesians 2:20; 1 Timothy 3:15).

- B. 2 Thessalonians 2:14; Ephesians 4:3; Matthew 18:20 + Hebrews 10:25.

# IV. A SINGULAR COMMISSION

- A. "Key" = knowledge, truth.
- B. Luke 11:52; Isaiah 22:22 + Revelations 3:7; 1 Timothy 3:15; Proverbs 11:30.

# V. A <u>SETTLED CONSUMMATION</u>

- A. "...the gates of hades will not overpower it..."
- B. Death cannot contain those who are in the church (Hebrew 2:14 + John 11:25-26; 1 John 3:2; 1 Corinthians 15:55; Luke 20:36.
