Monthly Memory Verse

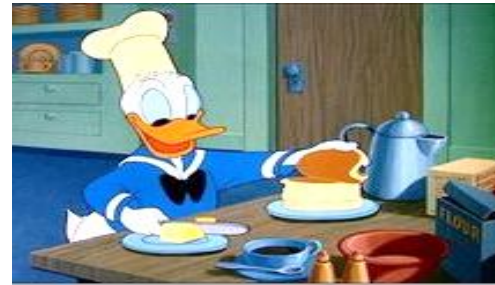
