We will start taking new photos to update the church directory on January 14th.

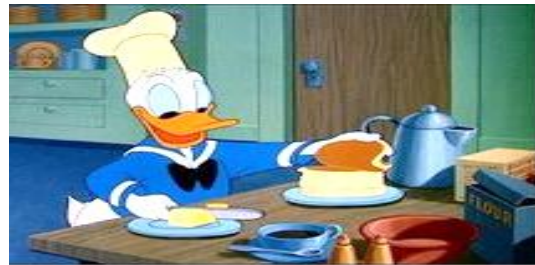
