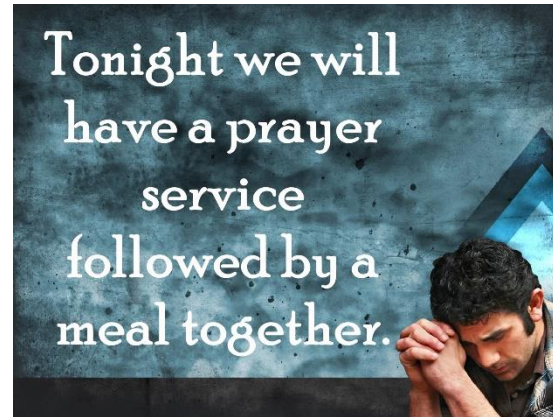

This morning we will take up a special contribution for the Hurricane Relief Fund in North Carolina. This effort is supported by the Hendersonville church of Christ.



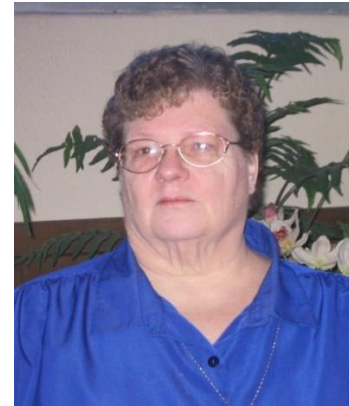
January 4<sup>th</sup> from 10 am – 3 pm we will update the church directory with new pictures. Wear your Sunday best.
